

# Proceedings

The CPOD 2007 proceedings will be published by the online proceedings publishing service [PoS](#) - Proceedings of Science, organized by SISSA, the International School for Advanced Studies, based in Trieste. All participants will receive a printed copy of the proceedings in addition to the free on-line access over the PoS web site.

Once you have received your userID and password, you can access the [PoS](#) site and submit your contribution for the Proceedings. In order to have the proceedings of the conference published in a timely manner, we request all contributors to submit their papers no later than

**September 15, 2007**

All contributions to CPOD 2007 will be published in the proceedings only **after having passed a refereeing process**. The CPOD 2007 [Local Organizing Committee](#) will supervise the refereeing. Members of the [International Advisory Board](#) and other participants of CPOD 2007 will be asked to act as referees.

In principle, there is no page-limitation for online publishing. However, our suggestion for the maximal length of a contribution to CPOD 2007 is **10 pages**.

## **Submission of contributions (excerpted from the PoS website)**

Contributions can be submitted only via the Internet by web upload from the PoS web page, exclusively in pdf.

To prepare the pdf file you can use either LaTeX or MS Word. In either cases you should use the appropriate template file, sent to you by e-mail by the PoS Editorial Office, to produce your contribution in the PoS style.

When the conference web interface is set up Authors are assigned a personal userID and password for uploading their contribution on the PoS web page, as well as a contribution code. Please use this number in any correspondence with the PoS Editorial Office and the chairman in charge of the electronic publication of the PoS Conference Proceedings. This ID number is the one that will be used by anyone wishing to cite your contribution. To submit a contribution, please connect to your author page for the conference in question and click on the button "submit" next to your contribution code.

In due time, detailed instructions will be sent to all authors with the invitation to submit their contribution. Further details on submission of contributions, formatting, etc. are posted on the PoS website (at the link "[for authors](#)").
